🎯 Objective:

Students will learn basic creativity using AI tools in Canva.

📝 Instructions for Students:

1. Open Canva

Go to Canva (mobile app or website)

2. Choose Design

Click on “Presentation” or “Poster”

3. Use AI Tool (Magic Design / Text to Image)

In Canva, use AI feature (like Magic Design or Text to Image)

Type a prompt like:

“A colorful dream world with flying houses and candy trees”

“A magical jungle with talking animals”

“A space city with robots and stars”

4. Add Your Ideas

Write 3–5 simple sentences:

What is your dream world?

Who lives there?

What is special?

👉 **Example:** “My dream world is full of chocolates. Animals can talk. Everyone is happy and kind.”

5. Decorate

Add stickers, colors, shapes, and fun elements

6. Submit

Take a screenshot or download and send to teacher

 Bonus (Optional):

Add your own photo or draw something in Canva

 **Reading:** AI makes a short animal story (use Twee app). Read & answer 3 true/false questions. Draw your favorite part!  

 **Writing:** Get AI story starter like "My magic tree...". Finish in 5 sentences. Compare with AI's end!  

 **Speaking:** ChatGPT voice: "Tell about your pet." Record & listen back. Retry funny words!
